Your student has enrolled in Advanced Placement European History. We will be studying approximately 550 years of history in 30 different countries over the course of the semester. Many of the events we will be studying will be complex and in order to help students understand all of the motivations, points of view, and effects it will be necessary to use supplemental materials. Sometimes this means a debate or mock trial but a few times it will require that we watch a video.

I have previewed all the videos that the students will watch and paperwork has been cleared with the school in advance. Most of the videos are already in the school library but a few are not because they are rated-R usually because of a few violent scenes and language. I believe that AP students can handle these videos and they are valuable for our discussion/understanding of these topics. Below you will find a list of the movies that we will watch that are not already in the school library along with a brief synopsis. If you have questions about any movie please feel free to e-mail me and/or if you do not wish for your student to watch that movie please check the appropriate box. Students who do not receive your permission will not be penalized and will instead be given an alternate reading/assignment. Thank you for your continued support of our class!
