The Arabian Peninsula is a crossroads of three continents: Africa, Asia, and Europe. Most of the people living in this area will adopt the ideas or Bedouin lifestyle and form tribes. These tribesmen were fierce fighters and will form a powerful empire in the 600's & 700's . A few Bedouins will leave the nomadic tribes to settle into farming/trading communities. Traders will trade silk , spices , with nomad from around the world through the Arabian Peninsula

The City of <u>Mecca</u> became a very important
stop on trade routes. During holy months the
tribesmen would come into town to worship
an ancient <u>shrine</u> . The Ka'aba as well as
over 360 gods were associated with this
shrine. However, the concept of
monotheism or belief in one god, named
Allah, was not new to the Arabian
Peninsula. Many <u>Christians</u> and <u>Jews</u>
lived in the area peacefully. In 570 A.D.
_muhammud was born.

**Muhammad** 

Abraham

Muhammad was born into a powerful Meccan family, but he was orphaned at age six. He was raised by his grandfather and uncle. They were unable to provide him with a great deal of formal education and he began working on a caravans in his early teens. Over time he became the business manager for a wealthy widow named Khadijah. When Muhammad was 25 he and Khadijah married. It was a good relationship and business partnership. Muhammad gradually became more and more interested in religion



As Muhammad began preaching people in <a href="Medina">Medina</a>
became nervous; they feared he would drive away all the people who came to worship at the ancient <a href="shrine">shrine</a>. Some early <a href="Muslims">Muslims</a> were even beaten up and <a href="stoned">stoned</a> out of fear. Therefore, <a href="Muhammad and his followers relocated to">Mecca</a>. <a href="When he moved many tribesmen that he encountered">moved many tribesmen that he encountered</a> <a href="converted">converted</a> to Islam. Finally, due to the hostility from Mecca, Muhammad became a <a href="military">military</a> leader to defend his people & new faith.



In \_\_630\_\_ the Prophet and \_\_10,000\_\_ followers marched to Mecca, the leaders immediately surrendered as they were outnumbered. Inside the city \_\_Muhammad \_\_marched directly to the ancient shrine and \_\_destroyed \_\_ all the tribal gods. The site of the ancient shrine became the first place where Muslims worshipped in Mecca so that, "the \_\_truth\_\_ could come." Two years after returning to Mecca, Muhammad \_\_died\_\_.





## Beliefs and Practices Of Islam

The main teaching of Islam is that there is only one God, \_\_Allah\_\_. There is good and bad in this world and it is up to the \_\_\_individual\_\_ to be responsible for his/her actions. The holy book of Islam is the \_Qur'an\_\_ or \_\_Koran\_\_.

To be a Muslim, a person MUST fulfill five

pillars!



Faith \_\_\_\_\_ - The person must agree that there is no god but \_\_\_\_\_ Allah \_\_ and that Muhammad was the \_\_messensger \_ of God.
 Prayer \_\_ - Muslims must face Mecca \_\_\_ five \_\_ times a day to \_\_pray\_. Usually they assemble at a \_\_\_\_ Mosque \_\_ to do so.
 Alms \_\_ - Muhammad belived everyone had a duty to take care of the \_\_\_\_ less fortunate \_\_ . Muslims must give \_\_money \_\_ to the poor.

- 5. Pilgrimage Muslims must perform the haji or pilgrimage to Mecca at least once in their lifetime. During the pilgrimage everyone wears the exact same outfit to symbolize that they are equals before God.

Ramadan

Muslims do not separate \_\_personal\_\_ issues from religious issues. Islam is a complete way of life and all answers can be found in \_\_church\_\_. That is why many Muslim nations do not seperate religion\_\_ & \_\_state\_\_. Much of their law comes directly from the \_\_Qur'an\_\_. The law code regulates moral conduct, business, \_\_marriage\_, etc. Muslims do not eat \_\_pork\_\_, \_\_drink alcohol\_\_, and \_\_Friday\_\_ afternoons are set aside for prayer much as Christians worship on Sunday

Christians & Jews are protected in the Islamic faith as "\_\_\_\_peoples of the book \_\_\_\_" and are not to be \_\_persecuted \_\_. They are considered to be in the \_\_\_second \_\_\_\_ tier of the communit after Muslims.
