

## AP European Unit Notebook Explanation

Within each unit students will be responsible for completing several readings from their textbook as well as analyzing primary sources and additional video clips as listed on our class website under “Unit Materials.”

These assignments will be made available to students on the day we begin a unit and are due the day of the test for that unit.

Answers for each question will be evaluated based on quality (correct and detailed) as well as use of proper grammar/spelling. Incorrect answers will result in no points being gained for that question while answer that include incorrect grammar/spelling will automatically be docked half a point. Answers lacking at least one supporting detail will also automatically be docked half a point.

Each unit will vary in the number of readings assigned and thus grades will be determined by dividing the number of questions correctly answered by the total number of questions.

Example: Jo was assigned 18 questions in the unit and correctly gained 15.5 points. His grade for the unit is  $15.5/18$  or an 86.

Students will submit their unit as part of a Google Doc which they will share with the teacher and update on a regular basis. The teacher will leave comments/feedback on quality of answers and assignment grades.

It is the responsibility of the student to check our website regularly for new assignments, to manage their time, and complete assignments in preparation for unit tests. All work should be the original work of the students. Do not wait until the last minute to complete these questions! If you need help please ask well in advance of the due date!
